  - a) First hand data. You could ask your classmates yourself.
  - b) Second hand data. It would be difficult to research every food yourself.
  - c) Second hand data. This information could be taken from census polls.

  - e) Second hand data. It would be difficult to ask each person yourself if they have visited the Yukon.

1. This is first hand data. She is collecting the data herself.
2. This is second hand data. Someone else has collected the data that Miroki used.
