

K-4 Toy Policy

The members of the k-4 team have revisited our policy on students bringing toys to school. Many of our students in this age group have expressed a desire to bring toys with them to use at noon hour when they are outside playing. We as a team are going to make this possible and we will be following these guidelines:

- Toys are not to be used at anytime throughout the day other than noon hour break time when the students are outside or with the teacher's permission. That is they are not to be used in the morning, at snack time, in the classroom, or on the bus.
- Toys are the responsibility of the student. Toys that are brought to school have the potential of being broken or lost; if you have a toy that if this happened to and it would cause a hardship, it should remain at home.
- Toys are not to be traded.
- If a student does not follow these rules, the toy will be "relocated" until it is time to go home and the toy will be sent home with the student. The student may lose the privilege of bringing a toy to school.

We will be working with students over the next couple of days teaching them our expectations. After a period of training we will expect students to know these guidelines and follow them.
